

Sergeant Major Sergio MartinezRuiz, Marine Corps Logistics Base (MCLB) - Barstow, retired from active duty on 10 January after a stellar 27-year Marine Corps career. Arriving to his retirement ceremony on the parade deck astride his horse, Arias, Martinez spoke graciously of his family and his time in the Corps, calling the Marine Corps the toughest, most challenging and dangerous job. He admitted he was looking forward to his first year of retirement.

He began his rise to the highest enlisted rank in 1993 as a Combat Engineer. Among his many and varied assignments, Martinez served as a drill instructor at Parris Island, an instructor at Officer Candidate School, Quantico, and deployed to Iraq twice. He was promoted to sergeant major in 2010. His personal decorations include the Bronze Star, Meritorious Service Medal, Navy and Marine Corps Commendation medal with gold star (in lieu of a 2<sup>nd</sup> award), and Navy Achievement Medal with gold star.

SgtMaj Martinez, who has attended the breakfast meetings frequently, recognized the High Desert Marines (HDM) during his farewell speech. HDM were represented at the ceremony by Floyd Foster, Carlos Ramirez, Hjördis Jones, Al Watson and Bob Chestnut.

The sergeant major's replacement will be on board at MCLB in February.
